



2026 IEC Scholarship Information Package

Recognizing excellence – and helping you achieve your goals

Islington Evangel Centre (IEC) recognizes that completing a post-secondary education can be a financial challenge. That's why we developed an annual award program to assist deserving students.

The IEC Scholarship Program will annually confer up to four scholarships for students with a relationship to the church and one community scholarship; valued up to \$1,000 each.

Eligibility Requirements

Academic Scholarship

- The applicant/student must be between the ages of 17-30; an active participant at IEC or has family* members who attend IEC; volunteers in his/her community; and has commendable academic records in his/her full-time pursuit of a post-secondary education at an accredited educational facility.

**Family is defined as: a biological or adopted child; someone you have legal guardianship over; niece/nephew; grand-child; cousin or in-law.*

Community Scholarship

- The applicant/student must be between the ages of 17–30; does not have any family connection to IEC; volunteers in his/her community and has commendable academic records in his/her full-time pursuit of a post-secondary education at an accredited educational facility.

Selection Procedure

All applications will be assessed after all identifiers have been removed to ensure a fair and unbiased assessment.

Based on the application submission and interview, the Scholarship Team has the discretion to:

- Select scholarship recipient (s); or
- Withhold awards



Application Procedure

Each applicant is required to submit:

- A completed application form – including applicable supporting documentation
- A reference letter or a letter of recommendation; and
- A short biography, which may be used by IEC in announcing the winners

Failure to provide any of the required information may prevent an application from moving forward in the process.

Helpful Information About Scholarships

We encourage you to pursue all avenues to securing funding for your future endeavours.

Here is some information we feel will be helpful to you in completing any scholarship application.

First you should understand the different kinds of financial aids that are available. You should ensure you do some reviews.

- Scholarships (5 types)
- Bursaries (you may have to disclose financial information)
- Grants (similar to scholarships and you may have to pay back)

Be sure to check out the Financial Aid sections of school websites.

There are several Canadian Scholarships and Awards available. The one important thing we can't stress enough is **MAKE SURE YOU COMPLETE** the application forms in their entirety, submit by *deadline* and make sure all requested documents are attached. This may include an application letter or essay.

Deadline

IEC Applications and all supporting documents **MUST** be received as one package no later than **11:59 p.m. on Sunday, April 26, 2026.**
